Airport Perimeter and Access Control Security Act of 2017

(Sec. 2) This bill directs the Transportation Security Administration to:

- update the Transportation Sector Security Risk Assessment for the aviation sector,
- update the Comprehensive Risk Assessment of Perimeter and Access Control Security for airports,
- conduct a system-wide assessment of airport access control points and airport perimeter security, and
- update the 2012 National Strategy for Airport Perimeter and Access Control Security.

- **Feb 1, 2017:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation.
- **Jan 31, 2017:** Mr. Katko moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Jan 31, 2017:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H782-783)
- **Jan 31, 2017:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 665.
- **Jan 31, 2017:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H782-783)
