Water Technology Acceleration Act

This bill provides support for developing and deploying emerging or innovative water technology, including by requiring the Environmental Protection Agency to carry out a grant program for accelerating the development of emerging or innovative water technologies that address pressing water challenges.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 13, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans.
- **Sep 7, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Sep 6, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 6, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
