Summary (as of Sep 13, 2018)

Violence Against Women Extension Act of 2018

This bill extends through March 31, 2019, 19 grant programs authorized by the Violence Against Women Act of 1994 and subsequent legislation and administered by the Department of Justice Office on Violence Against Women.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 20, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Indian, Insular and Alaska Native Affairs.
- **Sep 13, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 13, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Natural Resources, and Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
