Summary (as of Sep 26, 2018)

Promoting Responsible and Free Trade Act

This bill allows for congressional disapproval of certain trade actions, including actions by the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative. Congressional approval is required for a trade adjustment for national security reasons.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 5, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Trade.
- **Sep 26, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 26, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Rules, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
