Summary (as of Sep 28, 2018)

Nursing Home Workforce Quality Act

This bill repeals certain restrictions under Medicare and Medicaid that prohibit the approval of nurse-aide training and competency evaluation programs in skilled nursing facilities that have been subject to specified regulatory actions (e.g., civil penalties).

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 11, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 28, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 28, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
