Sets forth the rule for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 38) disapproving the rule submitted by the Department of the Interior known as the Stream Protection Rule.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 31, 2017:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H761-771)
- **Jan 31, 2017:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 70.
- **Jan 31, 2017:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 70, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Hastings demanded the yeas and nays, and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question until later in the legislative day.
- **Jan 31, 2017:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H801)
- **Jan 31, 2017:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 236 - 183 (Roll no. 68). (consideration: CR H801)
- **Jan 31, 2017:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 236 - 186 (Roll no. 69). (text: CR H761)
- **Jan 31, 2017:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 236 - 186 (Roll no. 69). (text: CR H761)
- **Jan 31, 2017:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jan 30, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 30, 2017:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 115-6, by Mr. Newhouse.
- **Jan 30, 2017:** Rule provides for consideration of H.J. Res. 38 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit.
- **Jan 30, 2017:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 6.
