Wildlife Disease Emergency Act of 2018

This bill provides support for responding to wildlife disease emergencies, including by authorizing the Department of the Interior to declare and respond to wildlife disease emergencies, requiring Interior to implement a grant program for addressing wildlife disease emergencies, and establishing a Wildlife Disease Emergency Fund.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Livestock and Foreign Agriculture.
- **Oct 12, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Oct 12, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans.
- **Sep 28, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 28, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on Agriculture, and the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
