### Summary (as of Oct 2, 2018)

#### Default Proceed Sale Transparency Act

This bill establishes new requirements in the case of a firearm transfer by a licensed dealer, manufacturer, or importer to an unlicensed person prior to the completion of a background check. Current law permits such transactions—default proceed transactions—if a submitted background check remains incomplete after three business days.

### Actions Timeline

- **Nov 15, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **Oct 2, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 2, 2018:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
