Summary (as of Oct 5, 2018)

Kickapoo Tribe in Kansas Water Rights Settlement Agreement

This bill ratifies and modifies the Kickapoo Tribe Water Rights Settlement Agreement entered into by the tribe, Kansas, and the United States. The bill confirms a consumptive tribal water right in the Delaware River Basin of up to 4,705 acre-feet of water per year.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Oct 16, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans.
- **Oct 5, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 5, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
