Great Lakes Restoration Semipostal Stamp Act of 2018

This bill requires the U.S. Postal Service to issue a Great Lakes Restoration Semipostal Stamp. The proceeds from the sale of the stamp shall be transferred to the Environmental Protection Agency to fund the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 17, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans.
- **Oct 17, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Oct 9, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 9, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
