Summary (as of Oct 19, 2018)

Native American and Native Hawaiian Cultural Heritage Protection Act of 2018

This bill prohibits the sale and exportation of tribal cultural items of American Indians, Alaska Natives, and Native Hawaiians that were obtained illegally and provides for the return of the items, including voluntary returns.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Indian, Insular and Alaska Native Affairs.
- **Oct 19, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 19, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
