Hospital Competition Act of 2018

This bill establishes a series of programs and requirements relating to hospital costs, payments, and infrastructure, including a requirement for hospitals, as a condition of Medicare participation, to publish the prices charged for specified services that are highly utilized.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 15, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Regulatory Reform, Commercial And Antitrust Law.
- **Oct 25, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Oct 23, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 23, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
