## Summary (as of Nov 13, 2018)

### Shared Accountability for Improved Patient Outcomes Act of 2018

This bill makes a series of changes relating to value-based arrangements for health care, including exempting certain such arrangements from prohibitions against illegal remunerations and physician self-referrals.

## Actions Timeline

- **Nov 15, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Human Resources.
- **Nov 13, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 13, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
