## Summary (as of Nov 14, 2018)

### Keeping All Students Safe Act

This bill prohibits the use of seclusion and limits the use of physical restraint in federally funded elementary and secondary schools and Head Start agencies.

## Actions Timeline

- **Nov 15, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Nov 14, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 14, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
