Summary (as of Nov 15, 2018)

Long-Term InVestment in Education for Wellness Act or the LIVE Well Act

This bill expands the scope of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Education (SNAP-Ed) grant program, as well as the scope of local school wellness policies created under the National School Lunch Program or other federal child nutrition programs, to include eating disorder prevention and long-term health practices.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 12, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Nutrition.
- **Nov 15, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 15, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
