Summary (as of Nov 27, 2018)

This bill directs the Department of the Interior and the Department of Agriculture to establish and charge a fee for a nontransferable Recreational Access for Life Pass, which shall be used to cover the entrance fee and standard amenity recreation fee for all federal recreation lands and waters for which a fee is charged.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 30, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Nov 27, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 27, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
