Summary (as of Jan 29, 2018)

Condemns the actions taken by the government of Cameroon against Patrice Nganang and Cameroon's English-speaking minority.

Affirms that the United States continues to hold such government responsible for upholding the rights of its citizens, regardless of political views or beliefs.

Urge such government to extend to all of Cameroon's citizens, including political dissidents, the rights guaranteed by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights of the United Nations and other international covenants on human rights.
