Summary (as of Jan 30, 2017)

No Funds for Unconstitutional Executive Orders Act

This bill prohibits any federal agency funds, resources, or fees from being used to carry out any of the policy changes set forth in the executive order entitled "Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States," signed by President Donald J. Trump on January 27, 2017. Among the order's major provisions are restrictions on the entry of immigrants and nonimmigrants from seven countries (Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, and Yemen) and additional limitations on refugee admissions to the United States.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 14, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration and Border Security.
- **Feb 9, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border and Maritime Security.
- **Jan 30, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 30, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on Foreign Affairs, Homeland Security, and Intelligence (Permanent Select), for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
