Summary (as of Dec 6, 2018)

Megan Rondini Sexual Assault Victims Protection Act of 2018

This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to conduct a series of activities relating to sexual assault evidence and treatment. Among other things, HHS must establish a task force that addresses barriers to improving access to sexual assault forensic examiners, sexual assault nurse examiners, and other forensic medical examiners.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 12, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Dec 6, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 6, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
