Summary (as of Dec 6, 2018)

Good Samaritan Remediation of Orphan Hardrock Mines Act of 2018

This bill: (1) requires the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to establish a pilot program under which the EPA grants permits for Good Samaritans to remediate historic mine residue at orphan hardrock mine sites, and (2) establishes a Good Samaritan Mine Remediation Fund for land management agencies that authorize Good Samaritans to conduct remediation projects on federal land.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 10, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources.
- **Dec 7, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Dec 6, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 6, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
