Summary (as of Dec 10, 2018)

Securing Social Security Numbers Act

This bill prohibits a commercial entity from (1) requesting that individuals disclose their Social Security numbers when purchasing a commercial good or service; or (2) in general, denying an individual the good or service for refusing to do so.

In general, a commercial entity that has previously acquired Social Security numbers must purge them from its records.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
- **Dec 10, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 10, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
