Hudson-Mohawk River Basin Act

This bill requires the Department of Interior to establish: (1) a program to restore the Hudson-Mohawk River Basin region in New York and New Jersey, and (2) a Hudson-Mohawk River Basin Grant Program.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 11, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Dec 10, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 10, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
