Incentivizing Shared Risk in Medicare Advantage Act

This bill specifies that Medicare Advantage organizations may waive prior authorization requirements for items and services, including with respect to providers and suppliers that are part of risk-sharing or value-based payment arrangements.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Dec 11, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 11, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
