Border Bonds for America Act of 2018

This bill directs the Department of the Treasury to issue up to \$5 billion in bonds in a fiscal year, with proceeds going into a trust fund for the construction of reinforced fencing, physical barriers and related infrastructure for the U.S. southwest border with Mexico.
