## Summary (as of Dec 19, 2018)

### Pandemic and All-Hazards Preparedness and Advancing Innovation Act of 2018

This bill reauthorizes, revises, and establishes several programs and entities relating to public health emergency preparedness and response; the bill also specifies requirements for certain over-the-counter drugs that are marketed without an approved application, including fees for associated manufacturing facilities and orders.

### Actions Timeline

- **Dec 20, 2018:** Mr. Burgess moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Dec 20, 2018:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H10366-10393)
- **Dec 20, 2018:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 7328.
- **Dec 20, 2018:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
- **Dec 20, 2018:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H10431)
- **Dec 20, 2018:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: (2/3 required): 367 - 9 (Roll no. 449).(text: CR H10366-10391)
- **Dec 20, 2018:** On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: (2/3 required): 367 - 9 (Roll no. 449). (text: CR H10366-10391)
- **Dec 20, 2018:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Dec 20, 2018:** Received in the Senate.
- **Dec 19, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 19, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs, the Judiciary, and Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
