## **Uighur Intervention and Global Humanitarian Unified Response Act of 2018 or the UIGHUR Act of 2018**

This bill restricts executive agencies from procuring goods and services from foreign persons involved in China's mass detention of the Uyghurs, a predominantly Muslim Turkic ethnic group in Xinjiang province. It also places export controls on various technologies used to facilitate the mass detentions.
