## Summary (as of Feb 3, 2017)

### Medicaid Tax Fairness Act of 2017

This bill incrementally lowers, from 6.0% to 5.5% of net patient revenues, the maximum threshold used to determine acceptable provider taxes for purposes of state Medicaid program financing.
