Actions Timeline

- **May 16, 2018:** By direction of the Committee on Rules, Mr. Woodall called up H.Res. 891, and asked for its immediate consideration.
- **May 16, 2018:** POINT OF ORDER - Mr. McGovern raised a point of order against the provisions of H. Res. 891 because it violates the Congressional Budget Act. The Chair announced that the disposition of the point of order would be resolved by the question of consideration of H. Res. 891. The House proceeded with 20 minutes of debate on the point of order, at the end of which the Chair will put the question on consideration.
- **May 16, 2018:** On consideration of the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 223 - 181 (Roll No. 184).
- **May 16, 2018:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H3991-4007)
- **May 16, 2018:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 891.
- **May 16, 2018:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 230 - 184 (Roll no. 185). (CR H4007)
- **May 16, 2018:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 229 - 185 (Roll no. 186).(text: CR H3991)
- **May 16, 2018:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 229 - 185 (Roll no. 186). (text: CR H3991)
- **May 16, 2018:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **May 15, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **May 15, 2018:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 115-677, by Mr. Woodall.
- **May 15, 2018:** The resolution provides for 1 hour of general on all three bills. For H.R. 5698 and H.R. 2, the resolution provides for consideration under a structured rule. For S. 2372, the resolution provides for consideration under a closed rule. Finally, the resolution provides for one motion to recommit with or without instructions on all three bills.
- **May 15, 2018:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 144.
