Summary (as of Feb 7, 2017)

Respect State Marijuana Laws Act of 2017

This bill amends the Controlled Substances Act to provide that the Act's regulatory controls and administrative, civil, and criminal penalties do not apply to a person who produces, possesses, distributes, dispenses, administers, or delivers marijuana in compliance with state laws.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 10, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 7, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 7, 2017:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR H1075-1078)
- **Feb 7, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Feb 7, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
