Summary (as of Jun 22, 2020)

This resolution expresses remembrance for the life of Otto Frederick Warmbier on the third anniversary of his death. The resolution condemns North Korea for his death and calls for sanctions against North Korea to remain fully implemented until North Korea commits to the suspension of its proliferation of weapons of mass destruction.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 13, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Asia, the Pacific and Nonproliferation.
- **Jun 22, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 22, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
