- **Jul 29, 2020:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 86.

- **Jul 29, 2020:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1067.

Mr. Cole demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until later in the legislative day.
