Further Additional Continuing Appropriations Act, 2021

This joint resolution provides continuing FY2021 appropriations to federal agencies through December 20, 2020. It is known as a continuing resolution (CR) and prevents a government shutdown that would otherwise occur if the FY2021 appropriations bills have not been enacted when the existing CR expires on December 18, 2020.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 18, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 18, 2020:** Referred to the House Committee on Appropriations.
- **Dec 18, 2020:** Mrs. Lowey moved to suspend the rules and pass the resolution.
- **Dec 18, 2020:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H7273-7274)
- **Dec 18, 2020:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.J. Res. 107.
- **Dec 18, 2020:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: (2/3 required): 320 - 60 (Roll no. 247).
