Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8015) to maintain prompt and reliable postal services during the COVID-19 health emergency.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 22, 2020:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1092.
- **Aug 22, 2020:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 230 - 171 (Roll no. 179). (consideration: CR H4269-4270)
