Summary (as of Feb 7, 2019)

Genetically Engineered Salmon Labeling Act

This bill requires the market name of genetically engineered (commonly called *genetically modified* or *GMO*) salmon to include *Genetically Engineered* or *GE* in front of the existing market name.

The Department of Health and Human Services must ensure that an independent scientific organization conducts a review of the environmental assessment carried out by the Food and Drug Administration in support of a new drug related to AquAdvantage Salmon.
