Protecting Women Act of 2019

This bill extends through FY2019 19 grant programs authorized by the Violence Against Women Act of 1994 and subsequent legislation and administered by the Department of Justice Office on Violence Against Women.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 25, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Mar 6, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee for Indigenous Peoples of the United States.
- **Feb 15, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 14, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 14, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Natural Resources, and Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
