Summary (as of Feb 22, 2019)

FBI Access to Speedy Technology NICS Act or the FAST NICS Act

This bill modifies requirements governing the national instant criminal background check system (NICS).

Specifically, it requires the NICS to query an additional database—the National Data Exchange—as part of a firearm-related background check.
