## Repeal Insurance Plans of the Multi-State Program Act or the RIP MSP Act

This bill repeals the multi-state insurance plan program. (The multi-state plan program requires the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) to contract with insurance issuers to provide a qualified health plan through the health insurance exchanges in multiple states.) The OPM must report about the process and timeline for ending the program within 60 days.

### Actions Timeline

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- **Sep 10, 2019:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Reported by Senator Johnson with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. With written report No. 116-86.
- **Sep 10, 2019:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 190.
- **May 15, 2019:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **May 8, 2019:** Introduced in Senate
- **May 8, 2019:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
