Scientific Flood Mapping Act

This bill provides for the transfer of functions, responsibilities, and user fees related to the preparation of flood maps from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to the U.S. Geological Survey.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 18, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources.
- **Feb 27, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 27, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
