## Summary (as of May 14, 2019)

### Disarm Hate Act

The bill expands the categories of persons who are prohibited from receiving or possessing a firearm.

Specifically, it prohibits firearm sale or transfer to and receipt, possession, shipment, or transport by a person (1) who has been convicted of a misdemeanor hate crime, or (2) who has received an enhanced hate crime misdemeanor sentence.

### Actions Timeline

- **May 14, 2019:** Introduced in Senate
- **May 14, 2019:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
