Summary (as of Mar 5, 2019)

Police Officers Protecting Children Act

This bill specifies that certain retired and off-duty law enforcement officers who are authorized to carry concealed firearms are not subject to the federal prohibition on possessing (or discharging) a firearm in a school zone.
