Federal Register Modernization Act

This bill revises provisions regarding the Federal Register or the Code of Federal Regulations, including to replace requirements that the documents be printed with requirements that the documents be published.

- **Jul 15, 2019:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 149.
- **May 15, 2019:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Ordered to be reported without amendment favorably.
- **Mar 13, 2019:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
- **Mar 12, 2019:** Ms. Norton moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill, as amended.
- **Mar 12, 2019:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H2671-2673)
- **Mar 12, 2019:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 1654.
