This bill makes certain battery storage technologies eligible for loan guarantees provided by the Department of Energy for innovative technology.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 14, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.

- **Mar 13, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
