Summary (as of Mar 18, 2019)

Help Ensure Responders Overdosing Emerge Safely Act of 2019 or the HEROES Act of 2019

This bill allows naloxone and similar substances to be made available for personal use to (1) first responders under the firefighters grants program, and (2) law enforcement officers under the public safety and community policing (COPS on the Beat) grants program.

Actions Timeline

- **May 3, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Mar 18, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 18, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Mar 18, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Research and Technology.
