## **National Emergencies Modernization Act of 2019**

This bill terminates a national emergency declared by the President 60 days after the President reprograms or transfers an amount in excess of \$250 million for use in response to such emergency, unless a joint resolution affirming such declaration is enacted into law.

For any instance of reprogramming or transfer of funds for use in response to a national emergency, the President shall specify the derivation, amount, and intended use of such funds.

## **Actions Timeline**

---

- **Mar 22, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Mar 21, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 21, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committees on Foreign Affairs, and Rules, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
