## **Prevent Government Shutdowns Act of 2019**

This bill provides continuing appropriations to prevent a government shutdown if any of the appropriations bills for a fiscal year have not been enacted before the fiscal year begins and continuing appropriations are not in effect.

The bill also withholds congressional pay and limits official travel, congressional recesses or adjournments, and the consideration of legislation that is unrelated to appropriations or an emergency when continuing appropriations are in effect.

- **Jun 19, 2019:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Jun 18, 2019:** Introduced in Senate
- **Jun 18, 2019:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
