Summary (as of Apr 8, 2019)

Protect Our Workers Act

This bill requires the Government Accountability Office to conduct a study on the contracting practices of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, particularly with respect to compliance with the requirement to pay prevailing wages on federally financed construction jobs.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 9, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Apr 8, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 8, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
