This bill expands and designates high priority corridors on the National Highway System.

Specifically, the bill

- designates the Central Louisiana Corridor and the Central Mississippi Corridor as high priority corridors on the system;
- expands Interstate Route I-14 within the Central Texas Corridor, the Central Louisiana Corridor, and the Central Mississippi Corridor.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 10, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 10, 2019:** Referred to the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
