Fair and Equal Treatment of Women in the Coast Guard Act

This bill specifies reporting requirements for the U.S. Coast Guard regarding gender diversity.

The Coast Guard must submit a biennial report that includes an analysis of its recruitment and retention of women and gender-based limitations on career opportunities.
