Federal Leadership in Energy Efficient Transportation Act or the FLEET Act

This bill establishes various authorities and requirements for upgrading the U.S. Postal Service vehicle fleet, including requirements to reduce petroleum consumption, fuel efficiency and emissions standards, and authorities to enter into energy savings performance contracts and utility energy service contracts.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 19, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Apr 18, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 18, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
