### Summary (as of Apr 25, 2019)

#### Hepatitis Exposure Prevention Act of 2019 or the HEP A Act of 2019

This bill authorizes the Department of Health and Human Services to administer free vaccinations for hepatitis A in areas that have been declared by a state governor as being at risk of an outbreak.
